

Finding PRO

And getting around Flagstaff

We are located on old Route 66 west of Flagstaff. Our warehouse is gray and set back in the pines. We are on the north side of the road, directly across from Woody Mountain Road. Call us at 779-1512 if you get lost.

From I-40, exit at Flagstaff Ranch Road which is west of the I-17 interchange. (This is better than going through town, especially if you are coming from the east.) From the exit turn north toward the peaks, and go .4 mile to the stop sign. Turn right (east, toward town) onto old 66 and our warehouse will be on your left in another .9 mile.

From I-17, the easiest way to PRO is to get on I-40 going west, and follow the directions above via Flagstaff Ranch Road. If you want to hit the strip for food and shopping, then follow the directions below and cruise Milton before heading for PRO.

On I-17 North, stay in the left lane to avoid being diverted onto I-40, and follow signs for Flagstaff. You will merge onto Milton Road, a strip with many stop lights and businesses. The turn toward PRO is at the first light, left (northwest) onto Forest Meadows. Once you get on Forest Meadows, go straight (right lane only) through the first light, then turn right at the second onto Woodlands Village Boulevard. On Woodlands you pass through one light (at the Harkins movie theater) and turn left at the next onto Route 66 (Home Depot on left corner). Go 1.2 miles to the top of the hill, where PRO will be on the right across from Woody Mountain Road.

From downtown Flagstaff: Go west on the main drag, which is Route 66 and also known as Santa Fe. From east Flag to downtown this road parallels the railroad track. Just west of downtown the road bends left (south) and ducks under a railroad overpass, becoming Milton Road. After the overpass go straight through one light and turn right at the second (Barnes & Noble on right corner) to stay on Route 66. It is .7 mile to the light at Woodlands, go straight, then 1.2 miles past trailer parks and such to PRO on the right at the top of the hill. There is an I-40 sign right next to our driveway.

To downtown Flagstaff from PRO: Turn left out of our driveway, and cruise east straight down old Route 66. You will pass through a light at Woodlands Village Boulevard, then turn left at the next light, which is Milton Road. Continue through a couple lights on Milton and it will bend to the right as it goes under a railroad overpass. Get in the left lane, and look for a place to turn into the heart of downtown and park. You are permitted to turn left on Humphreys, Leroux (no light), and San Francisco. *Look out for one way streets!!*
